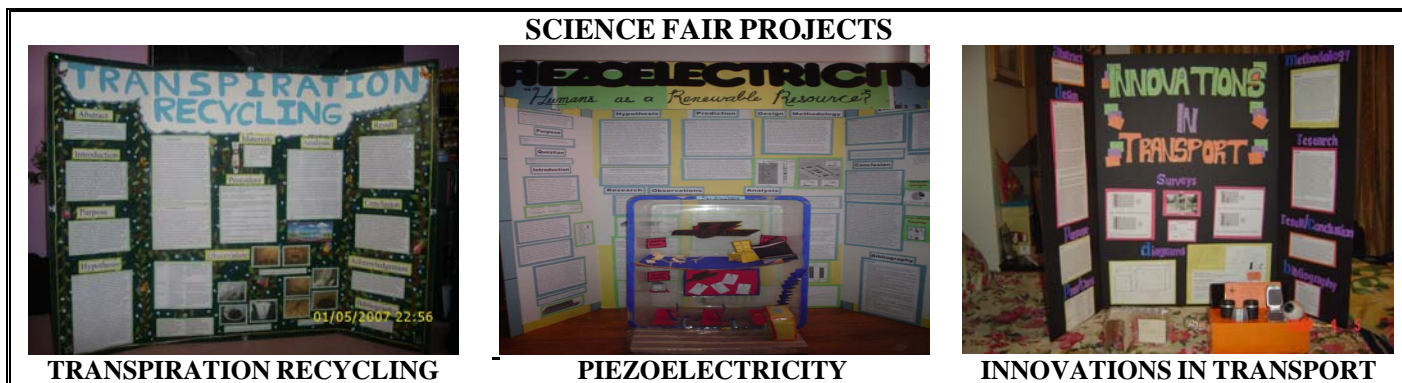
Congratulations to all students who participated in the school science fair this year on Monday February 23rd-your hard work, creativity and efforts paid off!
